Found by James Ktching in March 1980, on farm Borsmansdrift 133, located on Map 2827CD (Mekoatleng's Nek). Age: approximately 200 million years old, from the upper part of the Elliot Formation of the Stormberg Group. The skull is a single, well-indurated unit that has been fully prepared from rock matrix externally.
