There is also a flute, a pan-pipe, a guitar and two kinds of musical bows. Musical bows and beater (Kirby suggests Hottentot kha:s.) 5. Pan pipes (Kirby suggests north of Zambesi.) 6. Guitar (Kirby suggests Hottentot ramki.) 7. Smoking pipe made of bone or stone Hottentot 8. Smoking pipe Hottentot or Bushman 9. Smoking pipe 10-11. Switches of tail hair for flicking flies or wiping sweat Bushman or Hottentot 12. Shoe Hottentot 13. Sandal Hottentot (perhaps worn by Veldskoendragers) 14. Sandal (Xhosa?)
